Scripture Meditation of the Week

Habakkuk 2:4 "Behold the proud, his soul is not upright in him; but the just shall live by his faith."

Every word in this Scripture is important, and the Lord quotes it three times in the New Testament just to bring out the fullness of the meaning

- Romans 1:17 is the commentary on the justified man – "The *just* shall live by faith."
- Hebrews 10:38 is the commentary on faith – "The just shall live by *faith*."
- Galatians 3:11 is the commentary on the Christian life – "The just *shall live* by faith."

We as people frequently get caught up in the perceived injustices of the day, which often translate to things not going according to what we believe to be right. Because the tendency is not to seek out what justice is, but to define it by what is beneficial to oneself. Our pride dictates what justice looks like.

Our Scripture tells us that we are to fight for justice for those that cannot take up the fight themselves: the unborn, the infirmed, the enslaved, the weak and the poor. But it does not appear to state that we are to seek justice for ourselves, because we are already just. The Lord will take up that fight for us when we live by faith—when we obey the Gospel.

Sadly, there will be a day when those who do not live by faith will see the justice of God. Their pride will lead to their destruction. Pray that God would turn their hearts to Himself and escape the wrath to come.
