Scripture Meditation of the Week

Galatians 6:7-8

Do not be deceived, God is not mocked; for whatever a man sows, that he will also reap. For he who sows to his flesh will of the flesh reap corruption, but he who sows to the Spirit will of the Spirit reap everlasting life.

What are the things that I am sowing into my life with the expectation of different results?

There is no mystery here. Whatever is planted is what grows. Apple seeds do not produce pears, and bitterness does not produce love. Avocado pits do not produce olive trees, and an impure heart does not produce a life devoted to God.

There is little to distinguish the sprout of a peach tree from a pear tree, without digging into the seeds that were planted, until it begins to bear leaves and fruit. But time will reveal the difference. There is little to distinguish what is being planted into my life at the beginning, but time will bear it out as fresh fruit or rotting flesh.

Do I have a steady diet of the values of this world and expect holiness and closeness to God? Do I listen to the counsel of those who do not know God and expect to hear Him speak into my life? What makes me laugh, or moves my soul to tears? Is my declaration of love for God not borne out in my life as I feed my selfishness, dishonesty and lust?

I can fool those around me, especially when I hang out with people unwilling to make the distinction in their own lives. How quickly my heart seeks out those who will affirm and even encourage the wickedness in heart, rather than those who will challenge me in my sin. I can even think I am fooling God. But it is God who established this natural and spiritual law of reaping and sowing and His justice will not be denied.

What am I sowing into my life?
