What makes Christianity Distinct from Other Religions?





God Himself Pursues Man

All other religions teach that man does the work – man pursues God.

- Christianity Teaches:
 - Jesus is God; the 2nd person of the Triune God.
 - Jesus pursues us!
 - Jesus sacrificed everything (His very life) to purchase us!
 - We have <u>nothing</u> to sell/give Jesus can't be bought.
 - Jesus did the work (not us) and He finished it!

Relationship With God

 All other religions teach that man cannot have a relationship with God.

- Christianity Teaches: Relationship <u>is</u> Christianity.
 - Man was created in the image of God and had perfect fellowship and relationship with God... but man sinned.
 - Through salvation through Jesus Christ, man is restored to a right relationship with God.
 - Christianity establishes a personal abiding relationship with the living God.

The Resurrection of Jesus

 No other religion teaches that God became flesh, died on a cross, and then was resurrected.

Christianity Teaches:

- Man sinned and the wages of that sin is a death penalty.
- Jesus (who is God) became flesh and dwelt among us as fully God and fully man.

The Resurrection of Jesus

Christianity Teaches:

 Jesus came to reconcile man to Himself, and He had to be sinless to do that – and He was.

- Jesus became sin for man, and was publicly crucified, died on a cross, rose three days later – defeating death.
- Jesus is the only Savior; His death, burial, and resurrection is the only way man can be justified and gain eternal life.

One Source Of Truth Inspired by God

- · All religions have a basis for their beliefs.
- Non Christian religions rely on non-biblical or extrabiblical writings or teachings.
- · Christianity has one single source of truth (Bible):
 - It is inspired by God Himself.
 - It is the living Word of God.
 - Scripture is God's revelation of Himself.
 - The Word of God testifies of Jesus. And the life and witness of Jesus Himself reveals truth.

· Buddhism:

- He was an enlightened man;
- He was a wise teacher and a holy man.

Hinduism:

- He is a god; He was a holy man;
- He was a wise teacher;
- but He did not die for sins of world.

· Islam:

- He was born of a virgin; He was highly regarded; but he was only a man – not the Son of God;
- He was a prophet and a wise teacher; He performed miracles;
- He ascended to heaven, but He did not die for sins of world;
- He did not pre-exist, and He was not resurrected. But He will come again...

Judaism:

- He was Mary's Son; a teacher; was respected; was a miracle worker;
- · He *claimed* He was the Messiah;
- He was crucified on a cross; and it was claimed that He rose from the grave;
- But He did not die for sins of world and He did not rise from the grave.

Christianity:

- Jesus is God in the flesh (1 Tim 3:16; John 1:14)
- Jesus is the Son of God (John 3:16)
- Jesus is the second person of the Triune God (Matt 28:19)
- Jesus is the Savior (John 3:16; Luke 2:11, Acts 4:12; Romans 10:9-13)
- Jesus is the ONLY way to be saved/eternal life (John 14:6)
 - Other religions say work is required.
 - Christianity says the work is finished by Jesus!
