
The letters to the seven churches share a similar structure.

- A statement regarding the condition of the church.
 - In two churches there is no commendation Sardis and Laodicea;
- A verdict from Jesus regarding the condition of the church.
 - o In two churches there is no correction Smyrna and Philadelphia
- A command from Jesus to the church.
- A general exhortation to all Christians.
- A promise of reward.

V7B Jesus Describes Himself – the Key

Isaiah 22:20-23

'Then it shall be in that day, That I will call My servant Eliakim the son of Hilkiah; I will clothe him with your robe And strengthen him with your belt; I will commit your responsibility into his hand. He shall be a father to the inhabitants of Jerusalem And to the house of Judah. The key of the house of David I will lay on his shoulder; So he shall open, and no one shall shut; And he shall shut, and no one shall open. I will fasten him [as] a peg in a secure place, And he will become a glorious throne to his father's house.

V7B Jesus Describes The Church – the Open Door

- 1 Corinthians 16:9 For a great and effective door has opened to me, and [there are] many adversaries.
- 2 Corinthians 2:12 Furthermore, when I came to Troas to [preach] Christ's gospel, and a door was opened to me by the Lord,

Colossians 4:3 meanwhile praying also for us, that God would open to us a door for the word, to speak the mystery of Christ, for which I am also in chains,

V7B Jesus Describes The Church – the Open Door

"I would like to bear witness that I have proved this Philadelphian promise of the open door through years of ministry and it has never failed. Promotion does not come from the south, east, or west, but from God; and if we commit our way unto Him and trust Him, He will bring it to pass... God's man is not dependent on religious talent scouts nor is his ministry in the hand of ecclesiastical officials. His headquarters is heaven and his itinerary is made up by the Lord of the Open Door."

- Ephesus -1^{st} century. left their first love.
- <u>Smyrna</u> 2nd-4th century. the persecuted church, abject poverty but rich in Christ.
- <u>Pergamos</u> the compromised church holds doctrines of Balaam and the Nicolaitans. Satan joins the church.
- <u>Thyatira</u> begins the age of the Roman Catholic and Eastern Orthodox churches.
- Sardis the Protestant Age

Keep You From the Hour of Trial

- Pre-tribulation Jesus will return for His church prior to the beginning of the 7 years of the Great Tribulation
- Mid-Tribulation Jesus will return after the Abomination of Desolation and prior to the beginning of the 2nd 3 ½ years of the Tribulation
- <u>Post-Tribulation</u> Jesus will return after the 7 years and the final battle at Armeggedon.

Keep You From the Hour of Trial

1 Thessalonians 4:13-18

- 13 But I do not want you to be ignorant, brethren, concerning those who have fallen asleep, lest you sorrow as others who have no hope.
- 14 For if we believe that Jesus died and rose again, even so God will bring with Him those who sleep in Jesus.
- 15 For this we say to you by the word of the Lord, that we who are alive [and] remain until the coming of the Lord will by no means precede those who are asleep.
- 16 For the Lord Himself will descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of an archangel, and with the trumpet of God. And the dead in Christ will rise first.
- 17 Then we who are alive [and] remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air. And thus we shall always be with the Lord.
- 18 Therefore comfort one another with these words.
