V 25 – The Going Forth of the Command to Restore and Rebuild Jerusalem

Four Possible Decrees That Might Fulfill This Prophecy

- Cyrus to Ezra and the Babylonian captives to return to Jerusalem and rebuild the temple in 538 B.C. (Ezra 1:1-4 and 5:13-17).
- Darius giving Ezra the right to rebuild the temple in 517 B.C. (Ezra 6:6-12).
- Artaxerxes giving Ezra permission, safe passage, supplies to return to Jerusalem to rebuild the temple in 458 B.C. (Ezra 7:11-26).
- Artaxerxes giving Nehemiah permission, safe passage and supplies to return to Jerusalem to rebuild the city and the walls in 445 B.C. (Nehemiah 2:1-8).
