V 1 – Measured <u>Almighty</u>

Nine out of the ten times this word is used in the New Testament, it is used in Revelation. This temple will be the scene of great horror and great glory, but God is in charge, working through both the good and bad actions of man. - Guzik

The Temple – Abomination of Desolation

Daniel 9:27, (middle of 70th week)

Daniel 11:31 "And forces shall be mustered by him, and they shall defile the sanctuary fortress; then they shall take away the daily [sacrifices], and place [there] the abomination of desolation.

Daniel 12:11 "And from the time [that] the daily [sacrifice] is taken away, and the abomination of desolation is set up, [there shall be] one thousand two hundred and ninety days.

The Temple – Abomination of Desolation

Matthew 24:15-16, 21

"Therefore when you see the 'abomination of desolation,' spoken of by Daniel the prophet, standing in the holy place" (whoever reads, let him understand), "then let those who are in Judea flee to the mountains. ..."For then there will be great tribulation, such as has not been since the beginning of the world until this time, no, nor ever shall be.

Who are the two witnesses?

Elijah and Enoch: Hebrews 9:27 – all men appointed to die once 1 Kings 17:1, Jude 1:14-15 - Both prophets of judgment

Elijah and Moses: Revelation 11:5, 2 Kings 1 – destroy enemies with fire Revelation 11:6, Exodus 7 – water into blood Malachi 4:5 – Elijah's return (Jewish tradition) Deuteronomy 18:15, 18 – raising up a prophet (Jewish tradition)

Revelation 20:1-5

Then I saw an angel coming down from heaven, having the key to the bottomless pit and a great chain in his hand. He laid hold of the dragon, that serpent of old, who is [the] Devil and Satan, and bound him for a thousand years; and he cast him into the bottomless pit, and shut him up, and set a seal on him, so that he should deceive the nations no more till the thousand years were finished. But after these things he must be released for a little while. And I saw thrones, and they sat on them, and judgment was committed to them. Then [I saw] the souls of those who had been beheaded for their witness to Jesus and for the word of God, who had not worshiped the beast or his image, and had not received [his] mark on their foreheads or on their hands. And they lived and reigned with Christ for a thousand years. But the rest of the dead did not live again until the thousand years were finished. This [is] the first resurrection.
