
1 Corinthians 1:18-2:5

- You are accountable to God: The accountability standard is His moral law, the Ten Commandments.
- You have sinned: We have all broken God's laws; we are guilty and deserving of a death sentence (eternal death/eternal dying).
- Christ Crucified The debt was paid: (But God) Jesus paid the death sentence for us: He died on a cross, then He was buried in a tomb, then He rose from that tomb three days later (to defeat death). He substituted His life for ours.
- Your choice to receive His gift: Repent, and put your faith in Jesus, and you will be forgiven and will have eternal life!
