



Main Theme

Through these dates on His calendar, God expresses His sovereign plans and purposes to redeem the world through His Son, the Lord Jesus Christ.



Leviticus 23:1-2

And the LORD spoke to Moses, saying, "Speak to the children of Israel, and say to them,

'The feasts of the LORD, which you shall proclaim to be holy convocations, these are My feasts.'"

Jesus died on the Date of **Passover**. (1 Cor. 5:7)

Jesus was raised on the Date of **Firstfruits**. (1 Cor. 15:20; Rom 4:25)

The Holy Spirit was given on the Date of **Shavuot/Pentecost**. (Acts 2)

1 Thessalonians 4:16-17

For the Lord Himself will descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of an archangel, and with the trumpet of God. And the dead in Christ will rise first. Then we who are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air. And thus we shall always **FALL JEWISH FEASTS** be with the Lord.

The Date of <u>Trumpets</u> is associated with the rapture of the church. (1 Thess. 4:16-17)

Leviticus 16:21

Aaron shall lay both his hands on the head of the live goat, confess over it all the iniquities of the children of Israel, and all their transgressions, concerning all their sins, putting them on the head of the goat, and shall send it away into the wilderness by the hand of a suitable man.

For He made Him who knew no sin **to be sin for us**, that we might become the righteousness of God in Him.



The Day of <u>Atonement</u> foreshadows Israel's national salvation. (Romans 11:26)

- 43 ...that your generations may know that I made the children of Israel dwell in booths when I brought them out of the land of Egypt: I am the LORD your God.

And I heard a loud voice from heaven saying, "Behold, the tabernacle of God is with men, and He will dwell with them, and they shall be His people. God Himself will be with them and be their God.

Zechariah 14:16

And it shall come to pass that everyone who is left of all the nations which came against Jerusalem shall go up from year to year to worship the King, the Lord of hosts, and to keep the Feast of Tabernacles.



The Date of <u>Tabernacles</u> anticipates the millennial reign of Christ. (Zech. 14:16; Rev. 20)



How can we pray on these Holy Days?

Trumpets	Pray for our readiness to meet the Lord in the air.
(Rosh Hashanah)	Pray for Israel to awake from her slumber and turn to the Lord.
Atonement (Yom Kippur)	Consider Jesus our Atonement and the great price he paid for our sins.
(Τοπ κιρρατ)	Pray for Israel to be cleansed as a nation and experience national atonement through Jesus.
Tabernacles	Rejoice that our sins have been forgiven through the blood of the Lamb!
(Sukkot)	Pray for Israel's glorious future when the Lord tabernacles in Jerusalem during his Millennial reign!
